Hello Dr. Cardona!

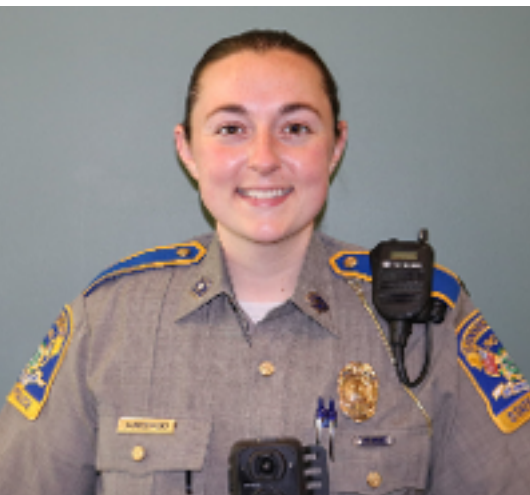
