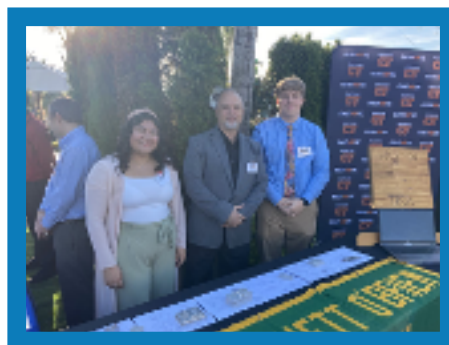
- October 14th is going to be the Junior class fundraiser! The Halloween Dance is filling up and going to be a spooky event!
