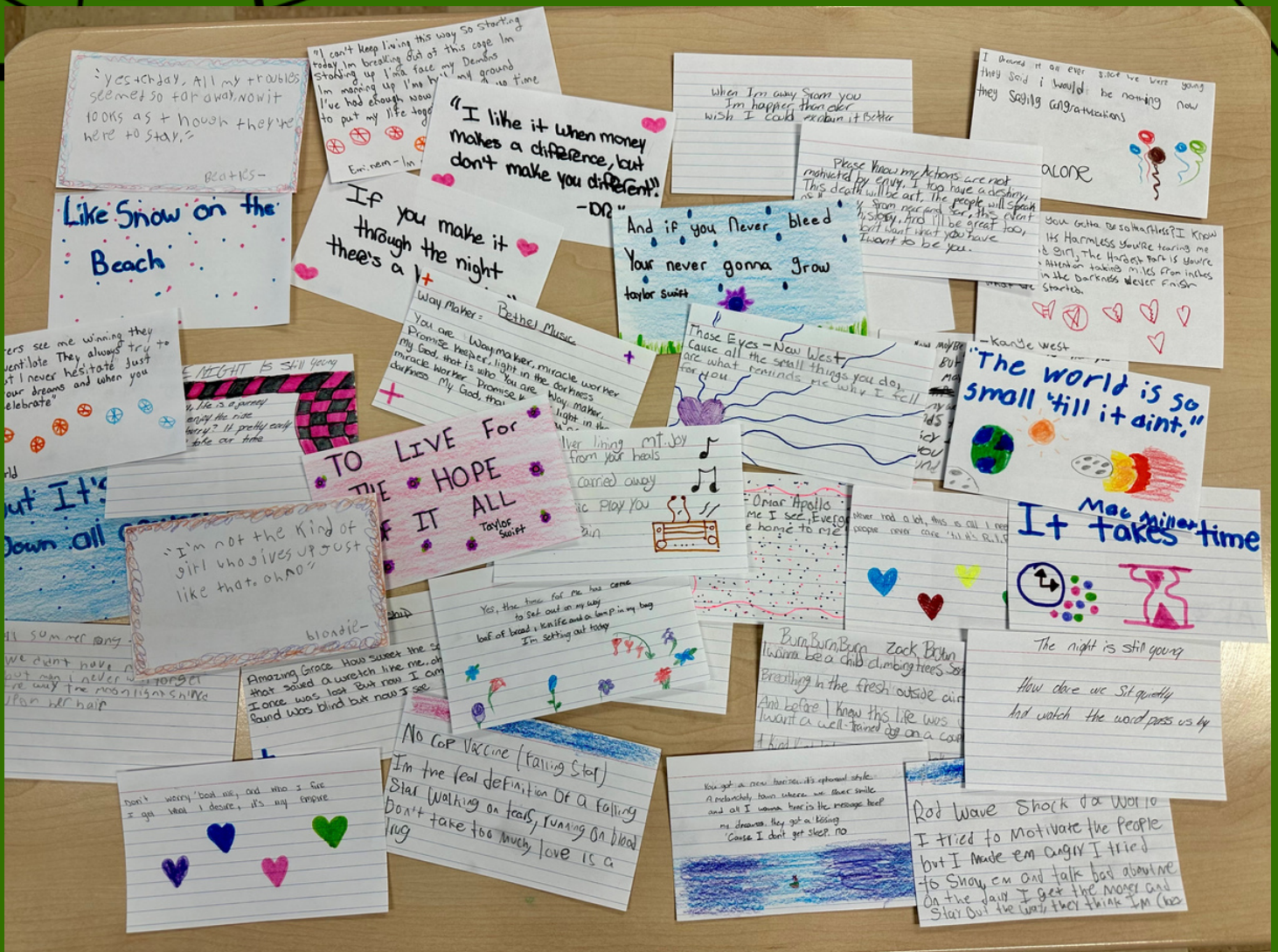
You can find him outside the gym at the attendance desk through first period, and in the Health Tech suite outside of that time.

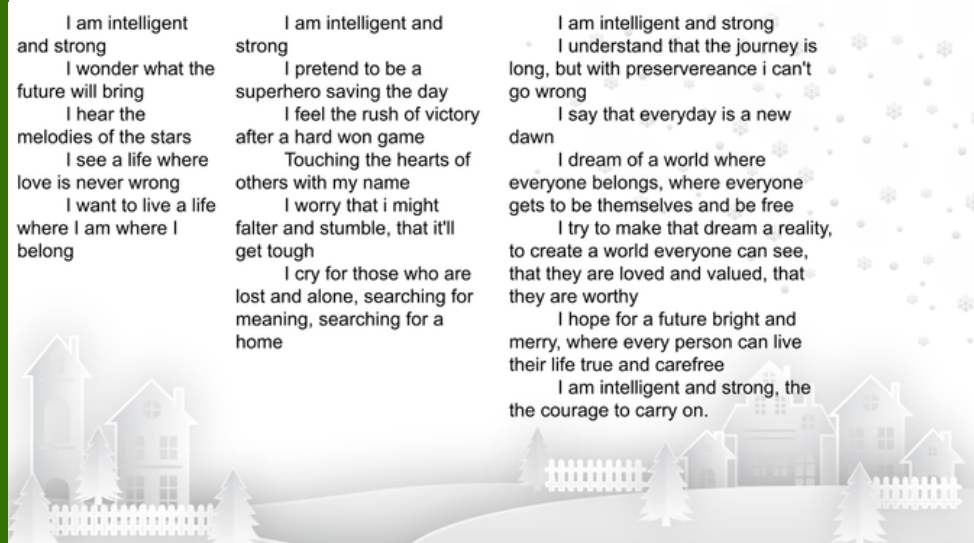




"I AM" POEMS

I'm going to work on my self-management and self-care

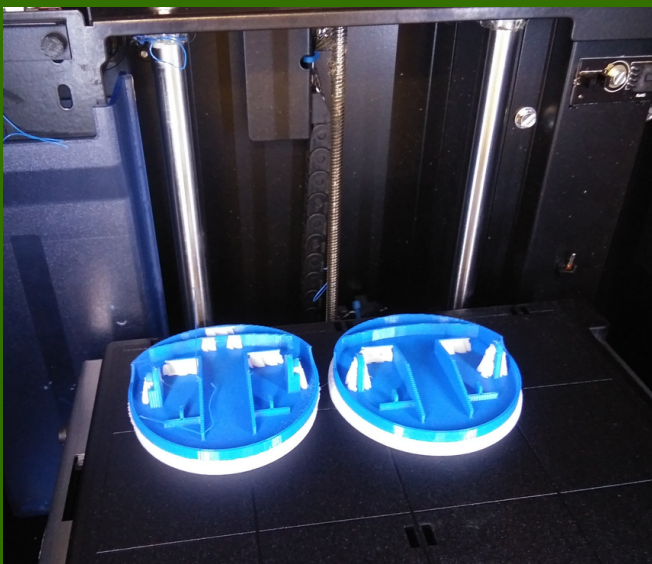
This year, I intend to work on disconnecting myself from technology.
