## FRESHMEN EXPERIENCE THE BLUES

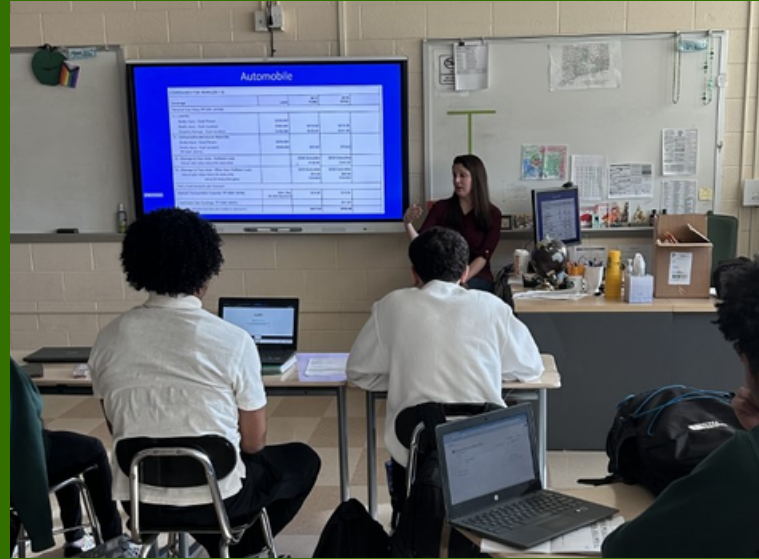
