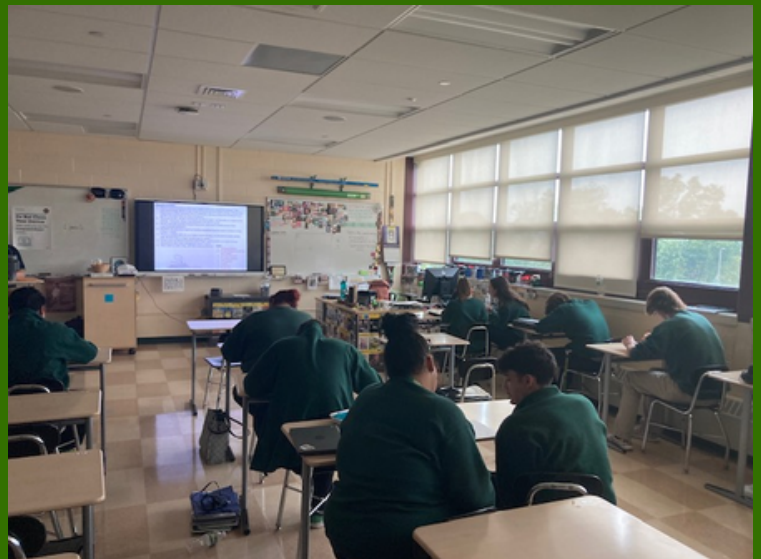
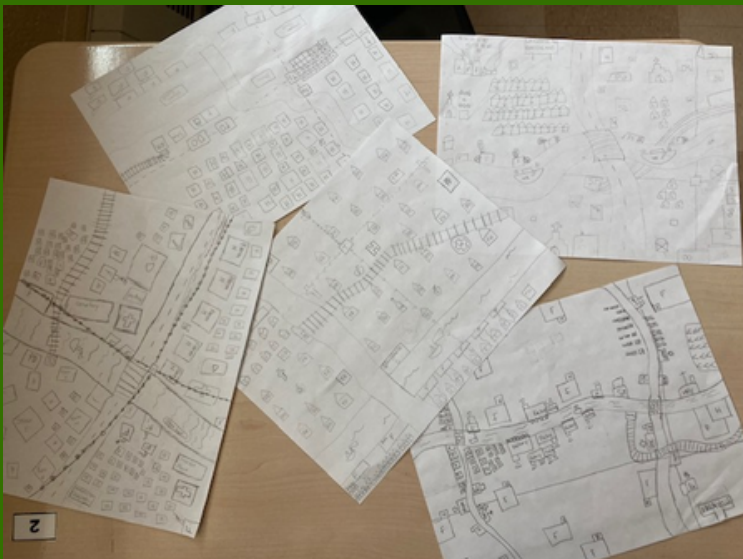
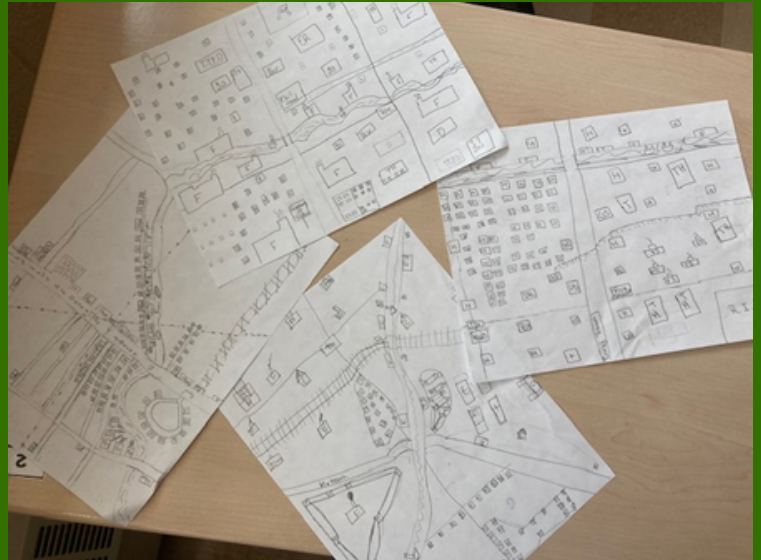


EOB GOES PINK KICKS OFF

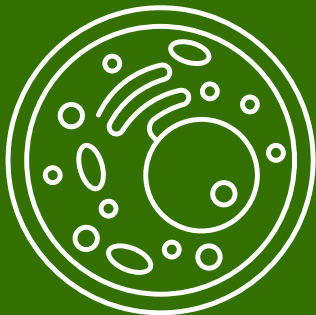




CELL STRUCTURE PROJECTS A SUCCESS

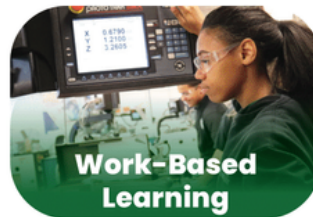
