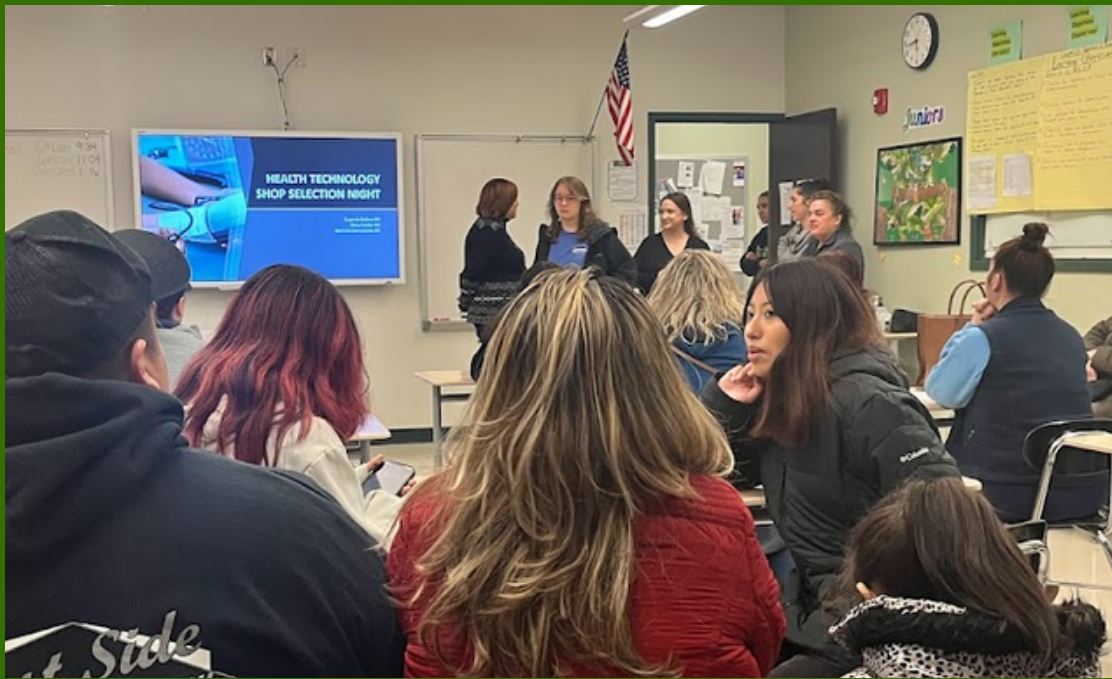

The Winter Wishes Snow Globe was created and installed by the MDET Seniors to help Emmett O'Brien begin the winter season.





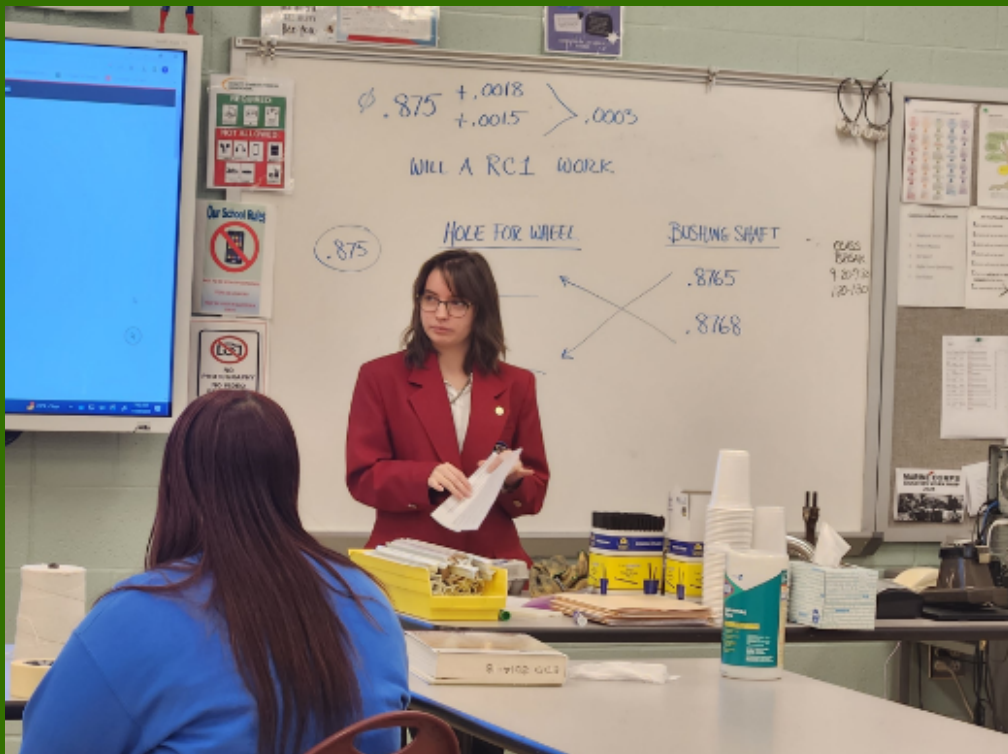
## SHOP SELECTION NIGHT

Emmett O'Brien is proud to have sent many students to the National Competitions for their knowledge and skills in their trade areas!



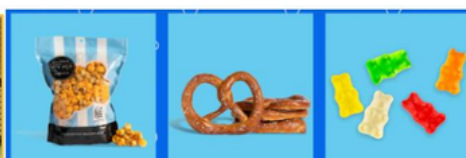
