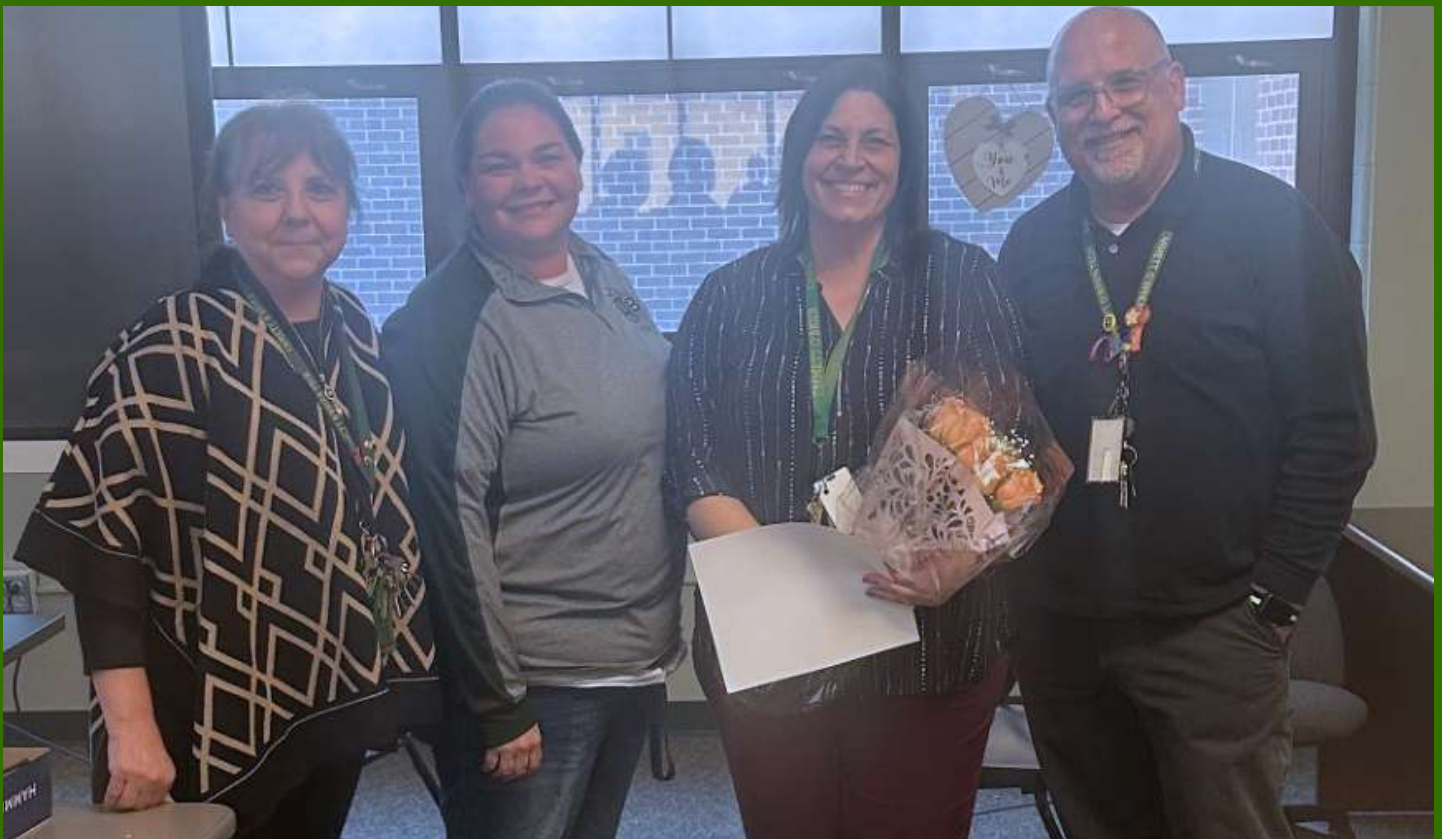

National School Social Worker QWeek is celebrated each year during the first full week of March.

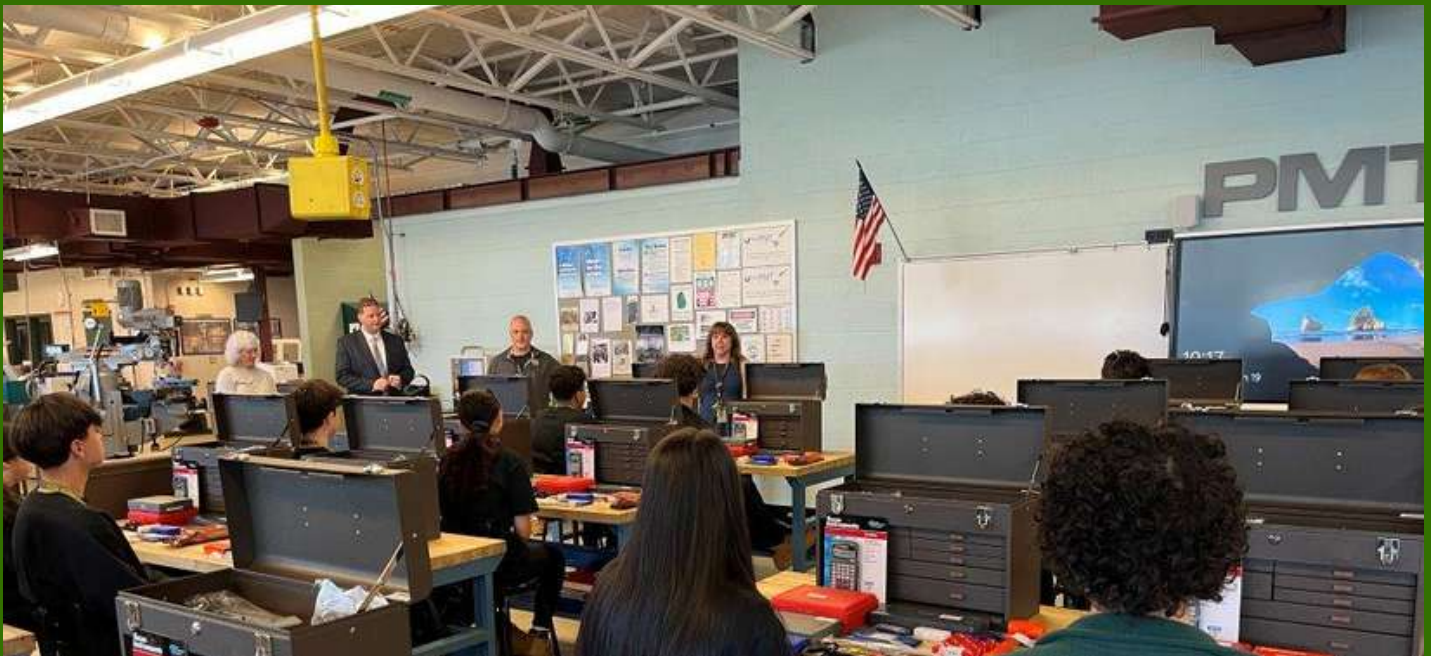
STUDENT COUNCIL SUPPORTS LOCAL NEEDS

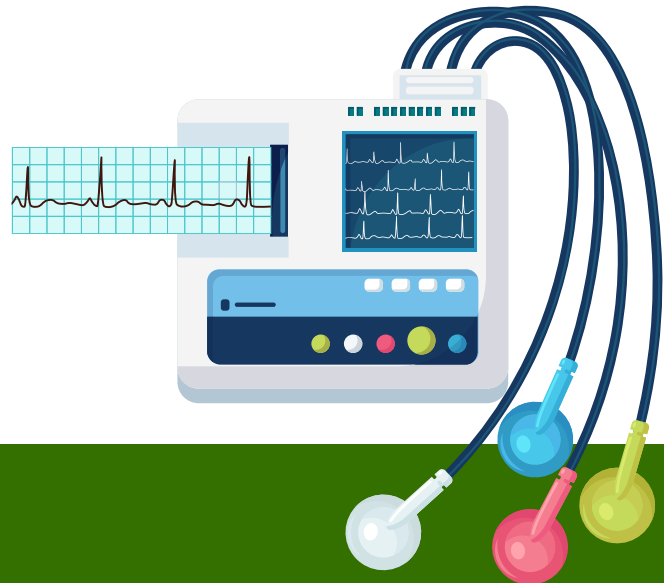
There will be six students going to the Nationals competition this summer, so please consider supporting the students on this next step! There will be more fundraising and events occurring throughout the remainder of the year.
