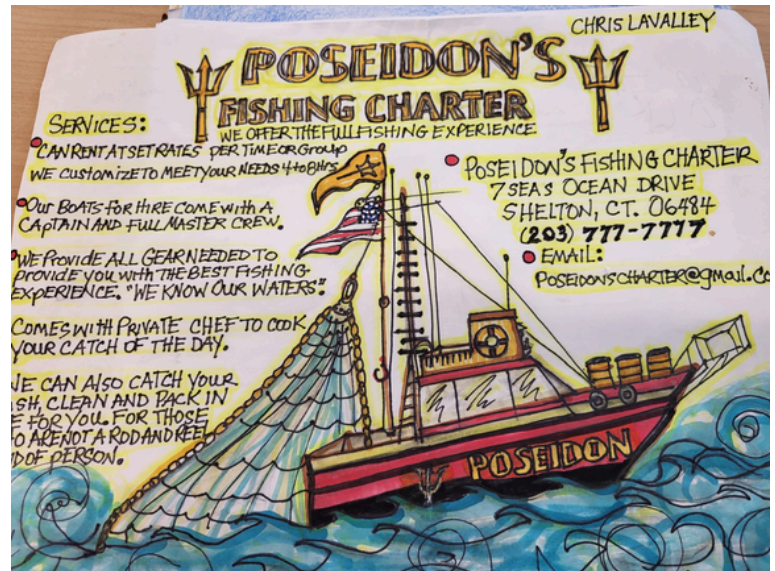
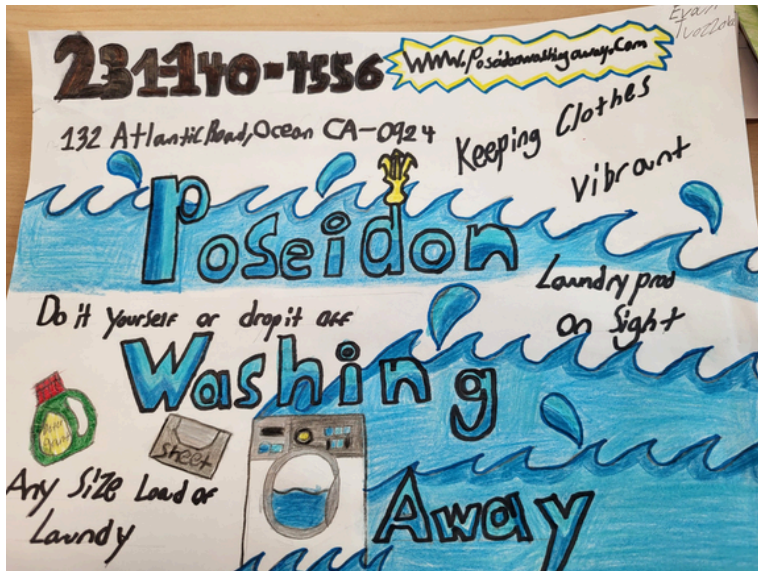

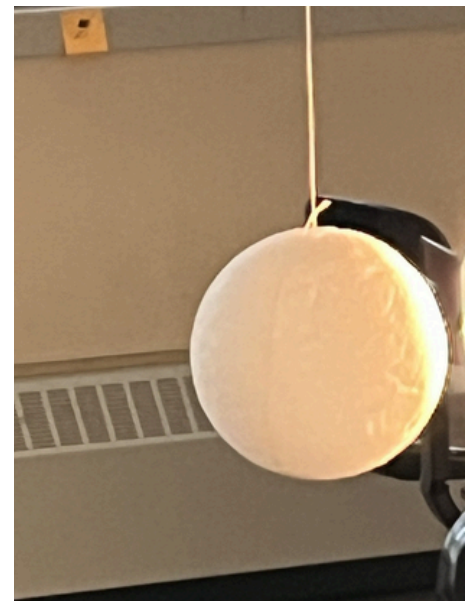
ALLUDING TO BUSINESS

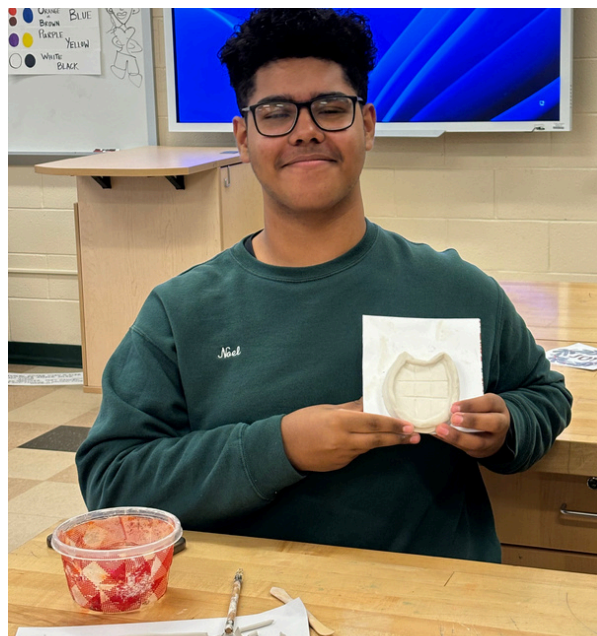
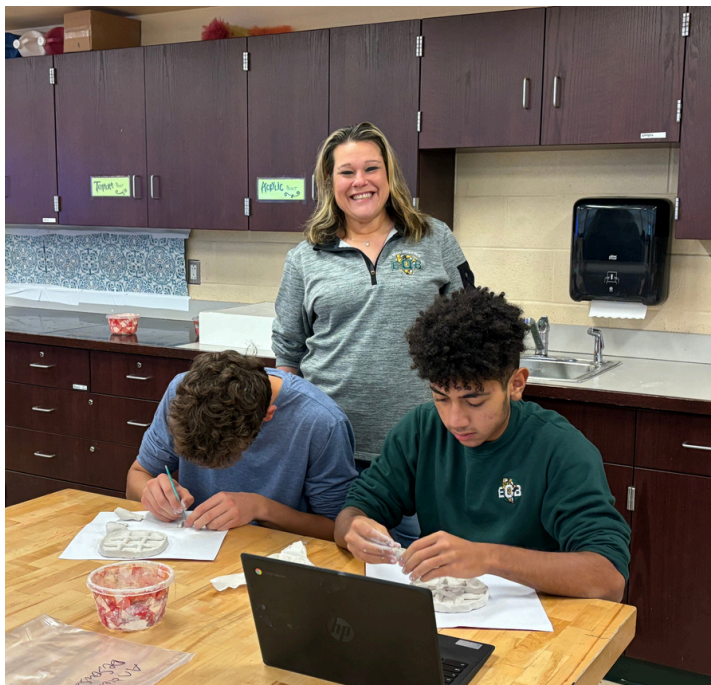
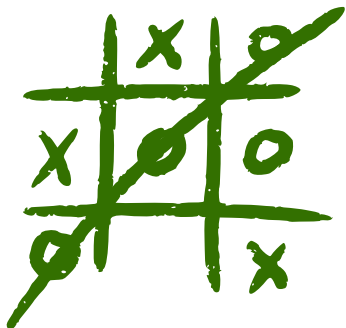
MOON PHASES LAB

Ms. Dudley's art classes have been busy creating their own custom tic-tac-toe game sets.

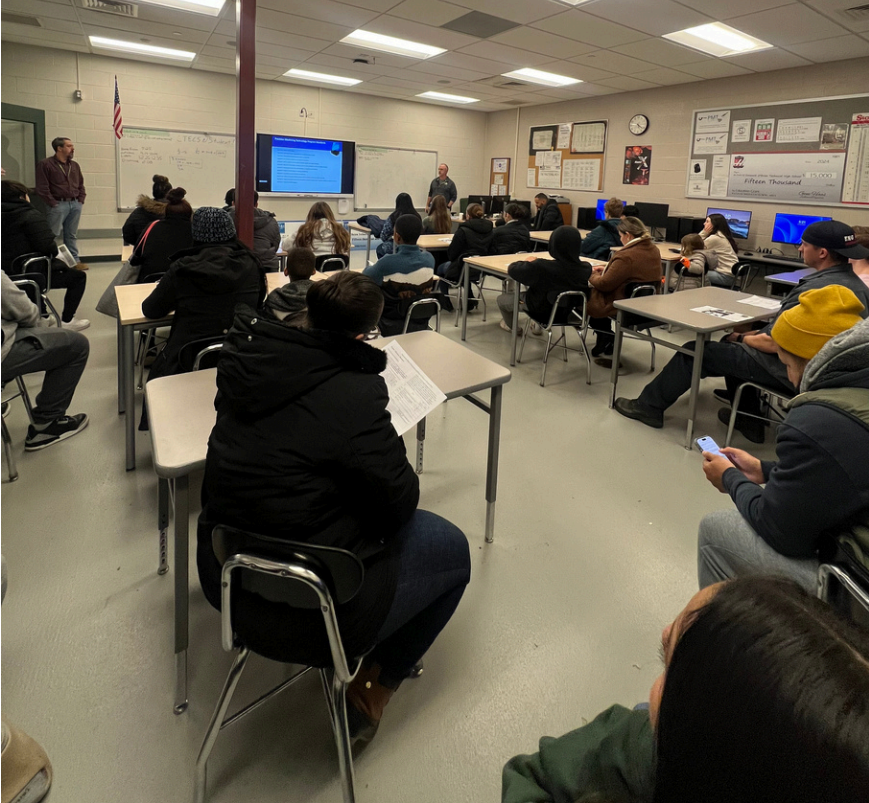
