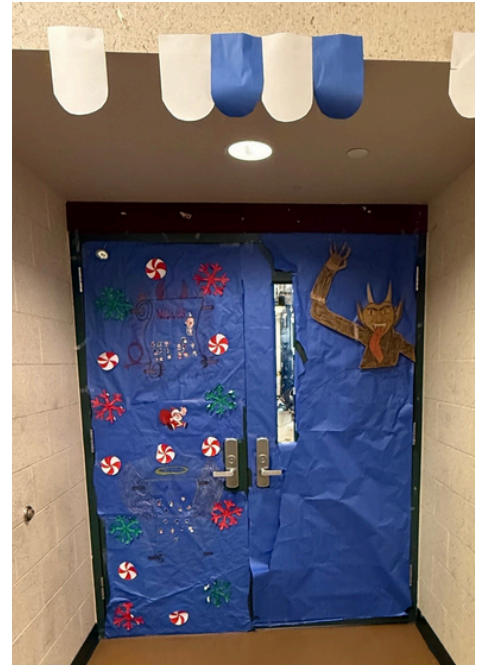
## WINTER DOOR DECORATING

2nd: Health Technology (Center)

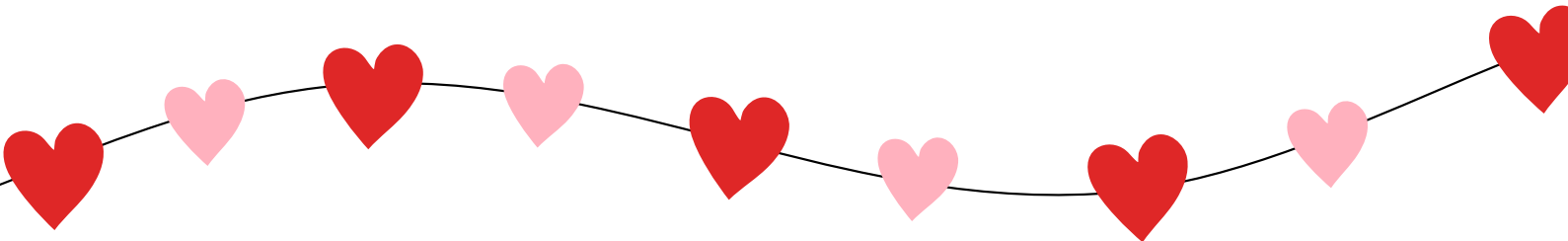

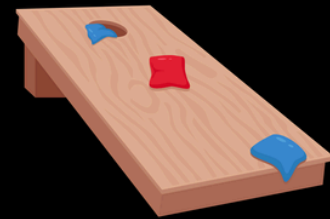
