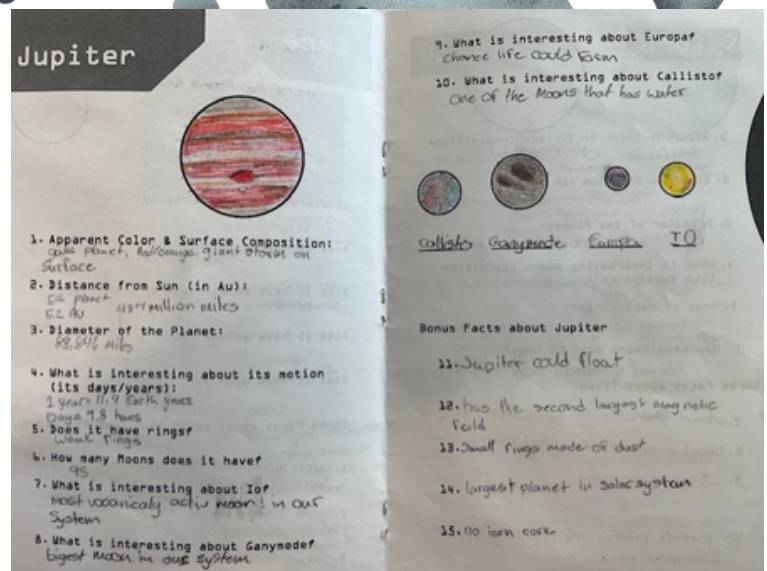
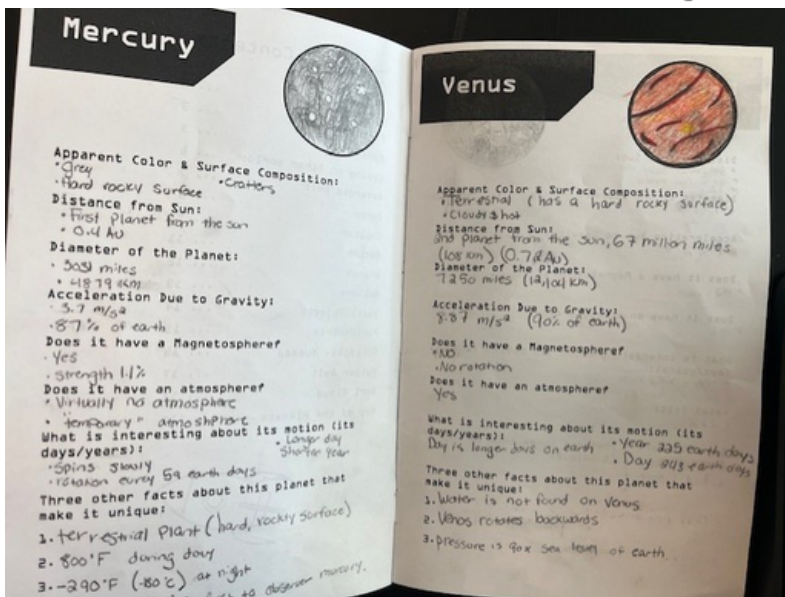
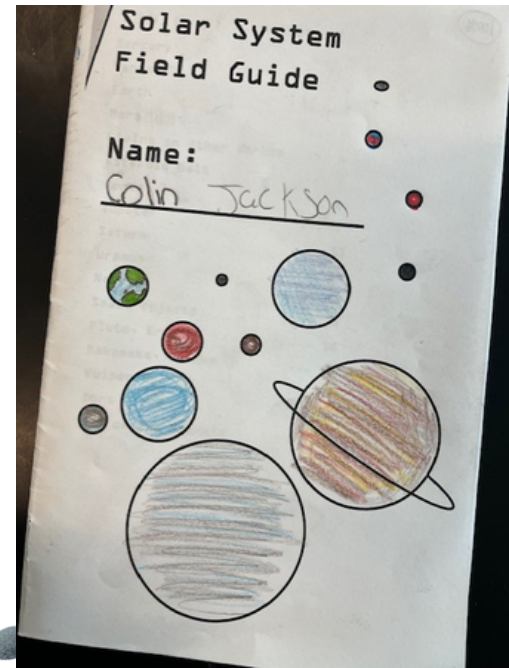
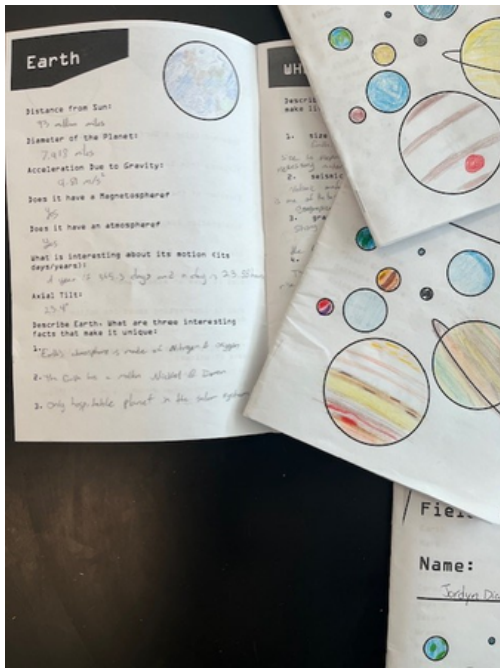
CARPENTRY HARD AT WORK

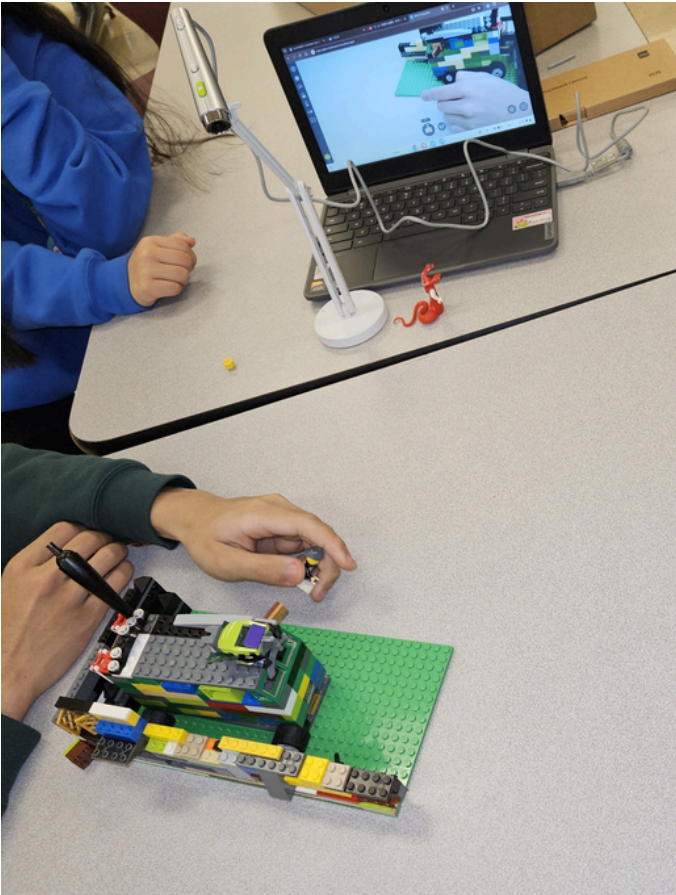

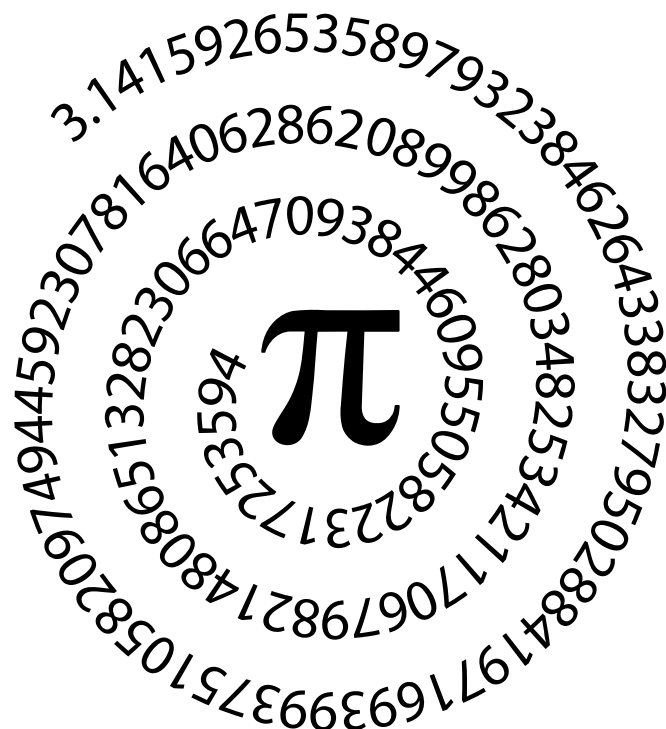
