## ADVANCED ENGINEERING GROUP PROJECT

For an engineering project, a cardboard shirt folding machine is a classic way to apply geometric nets and pattern development to solve a practical problem. While a basic manual folder uses simple hinges, an advanced project can incorporate complex mechanical movements, automated components like Arduino microcontrollers, or even optimized "origami engineering" to maximize speed. MDET students recently applied their understanding of engineering concepts, technical drawing, and prototyping to create a shirt folding machine of their own! Check out their work!
